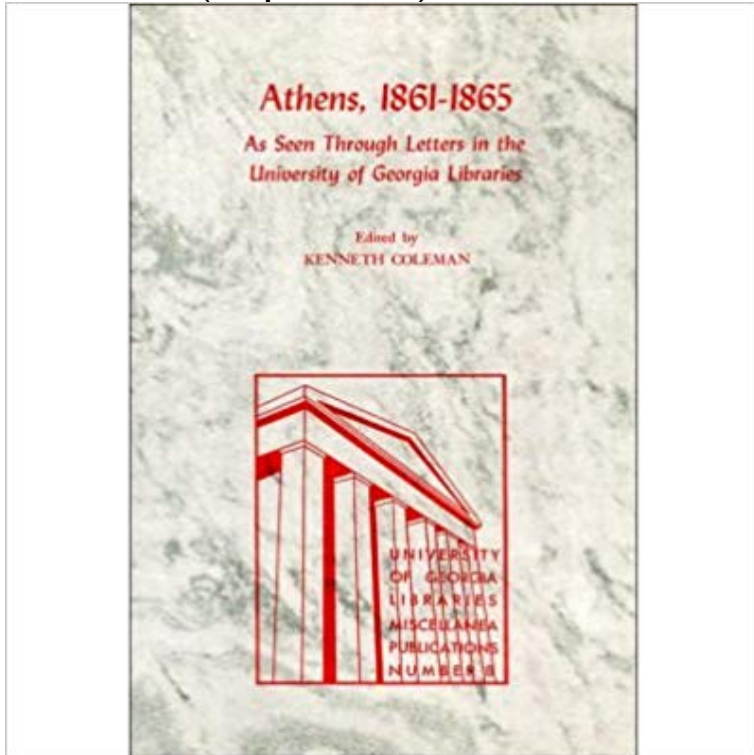


Athens, 1861-65: As Seen Through Letters in the University of Georgia Libraries (Paperback) - Common
