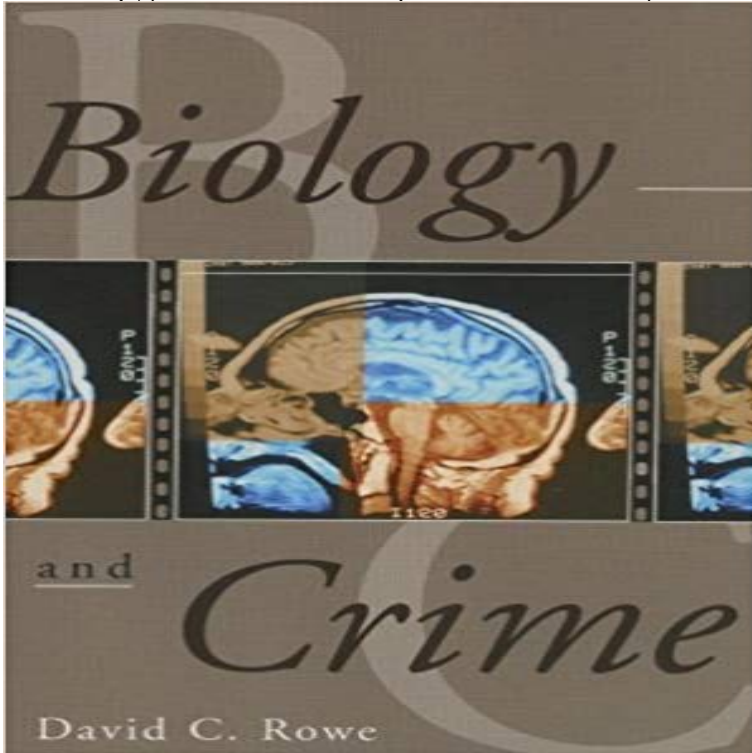


Biology and Crime (The Roxbury Series in Crime, Justice, and Law)
