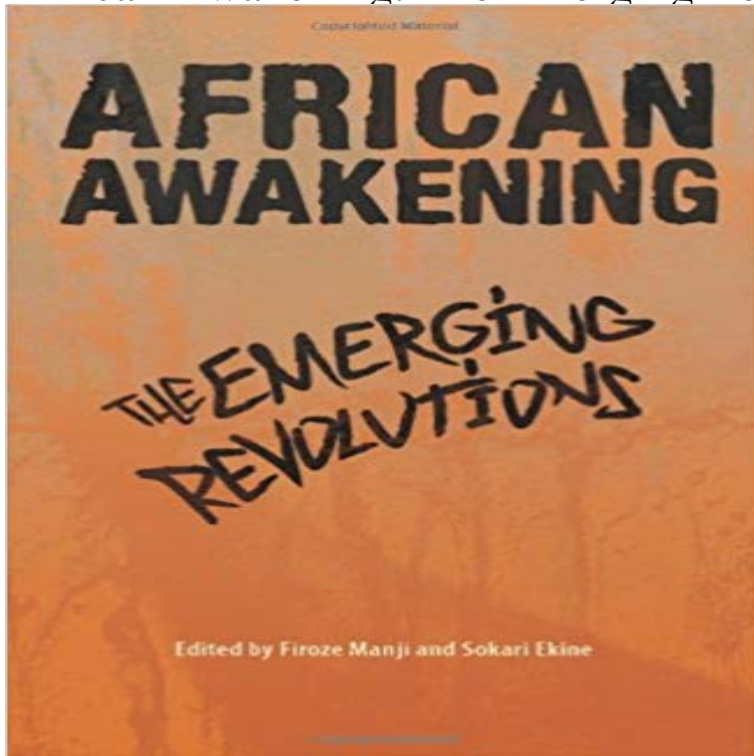


African Awakening: The Emerging Revolutions
