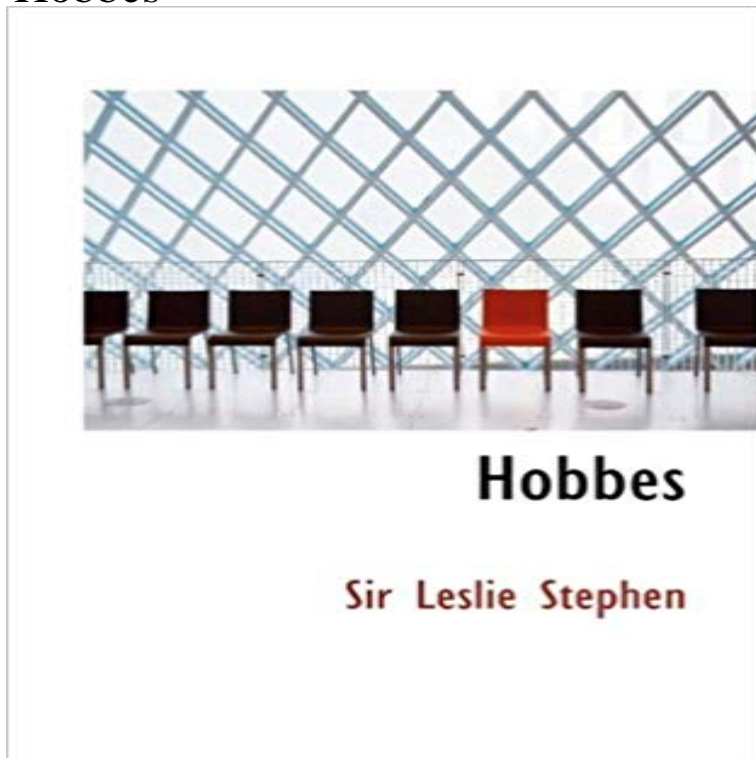


# Hobbes
