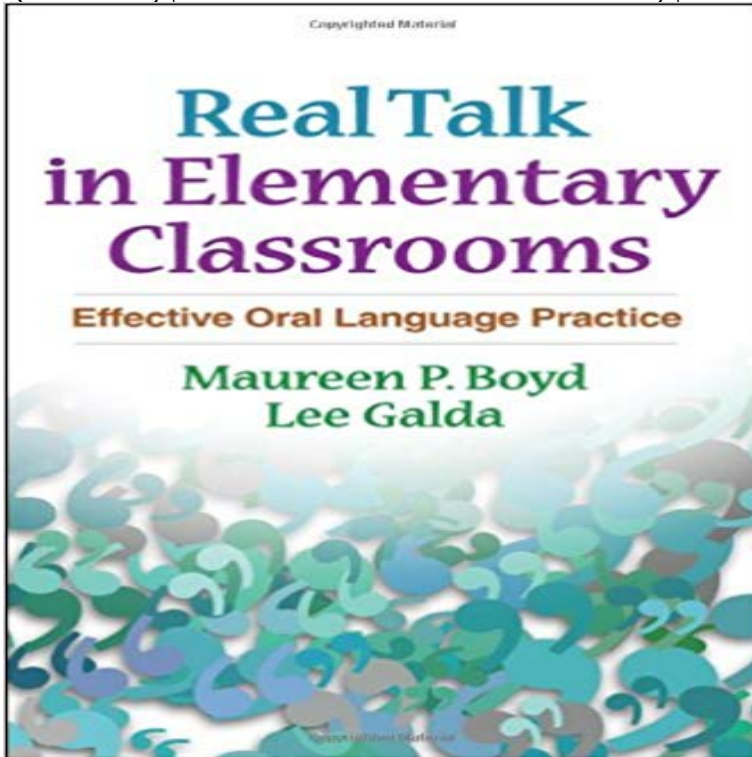


Real Talk in Elementary Classrooms: Effective Oral Language Practice (Solving Problems in the Teaching of Literacy)
