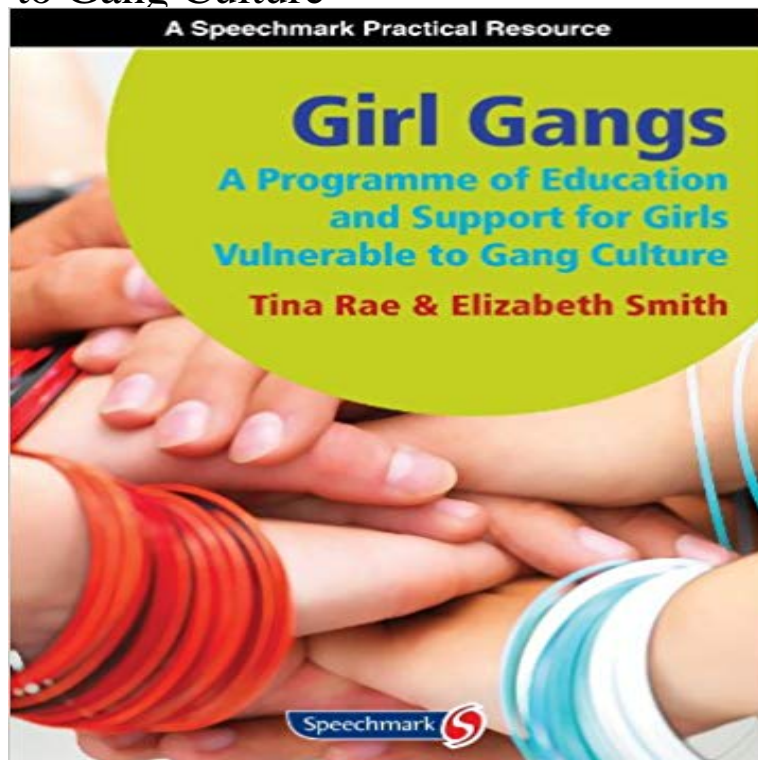


Girl Gangs: A Programme of Education and Support for Girls Vulnerable to Gang Culture
