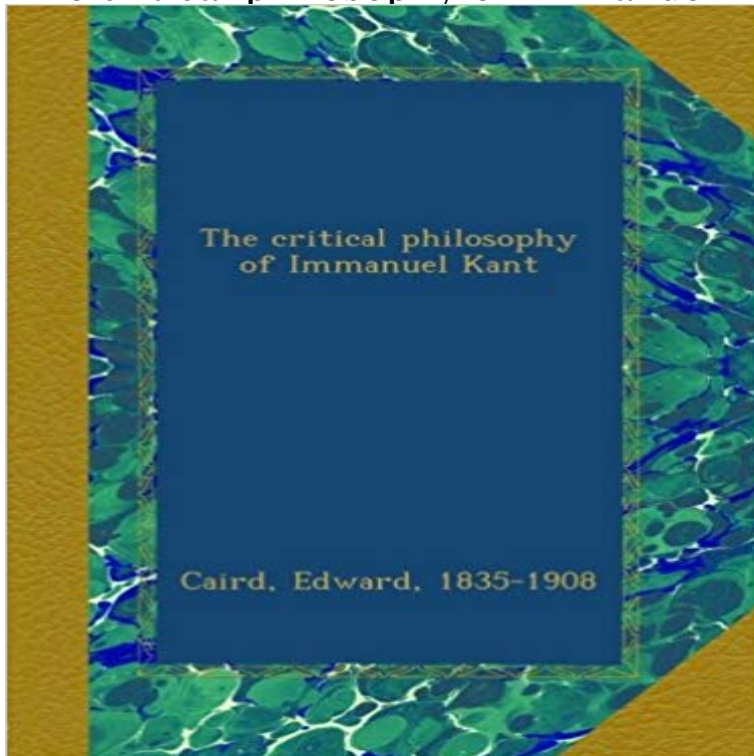


The critical philosophy of Immanuel Kant
