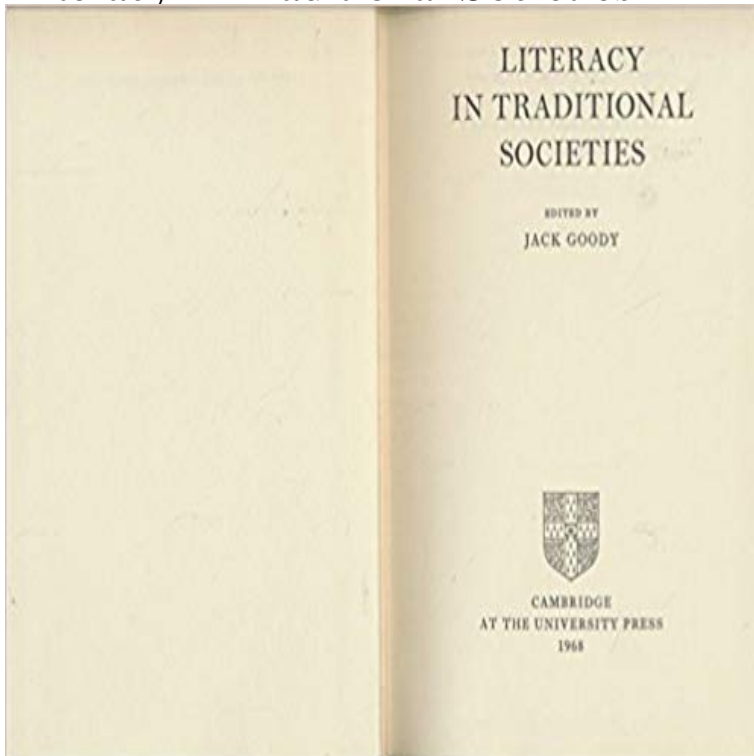


Literacy in Traditional Societies
