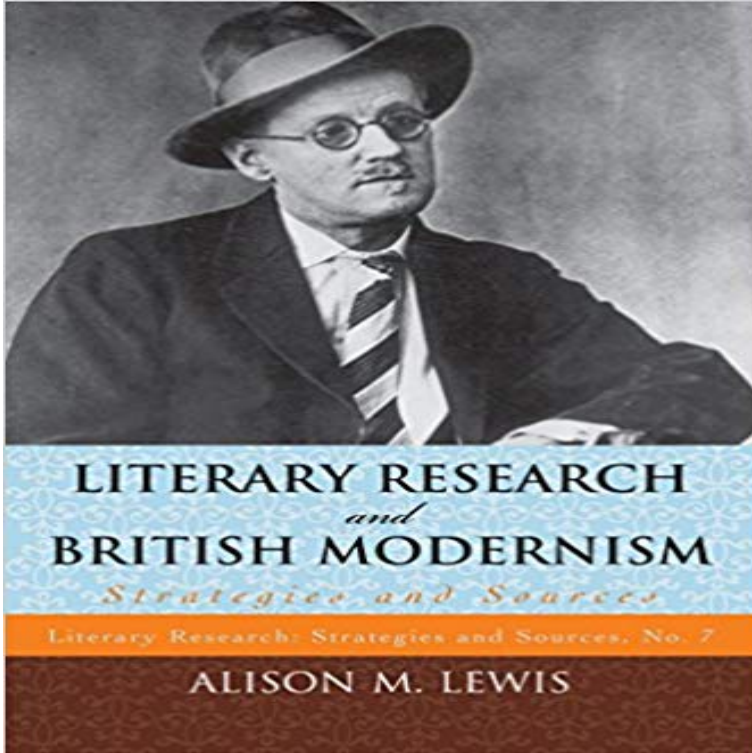


Literary Research and British Modernism: Strategies and Sources (Literary Research: Strategies and Sources)
