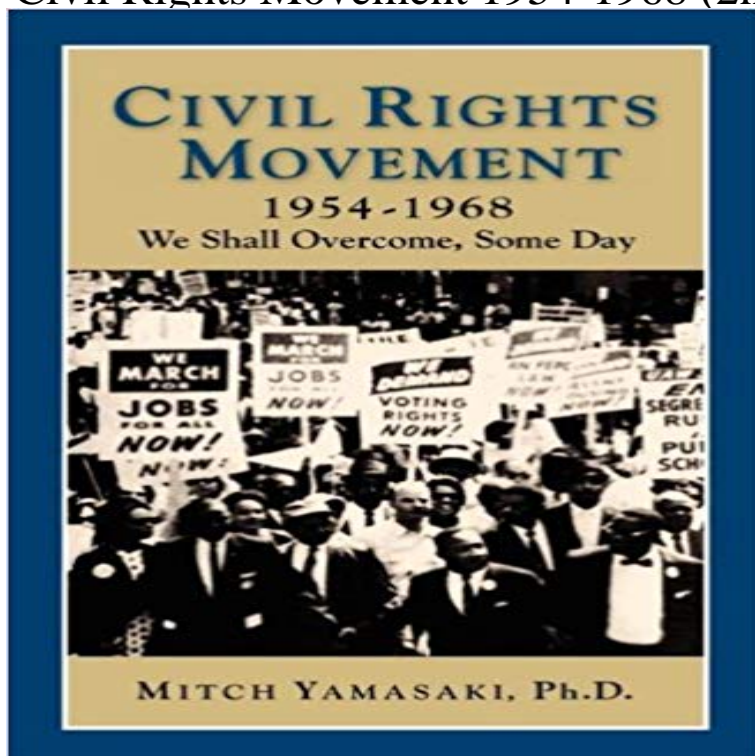


Civil Rights Movement 1954-1968 (2nd Ed) (Perspectives on History)
