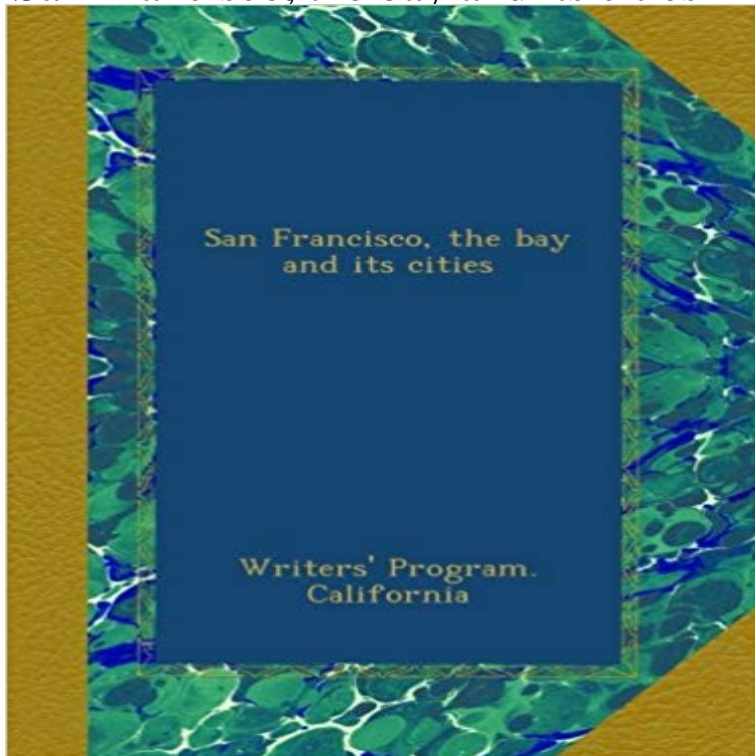


San Francisco, the bay and its cities
