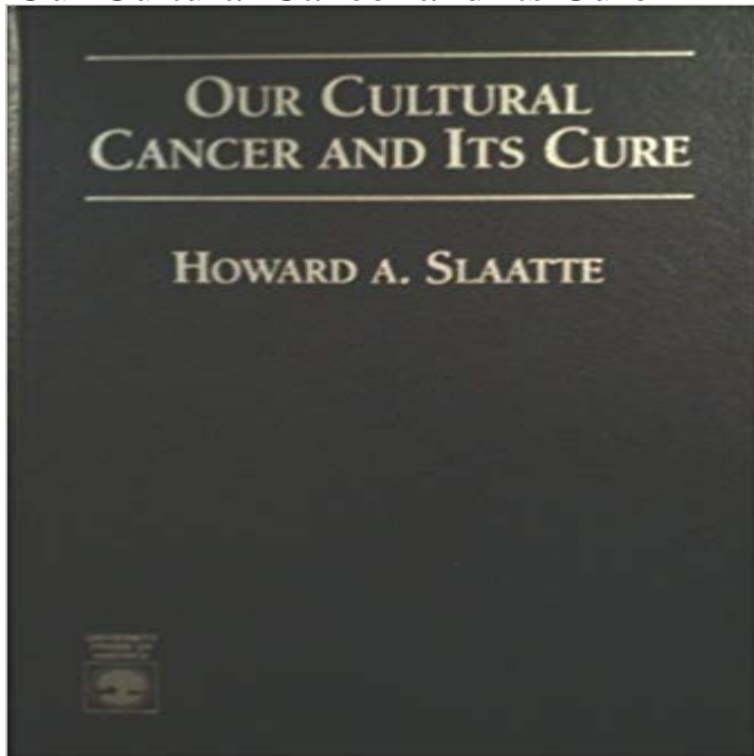


Our Cultural Cancer and Its Cure
