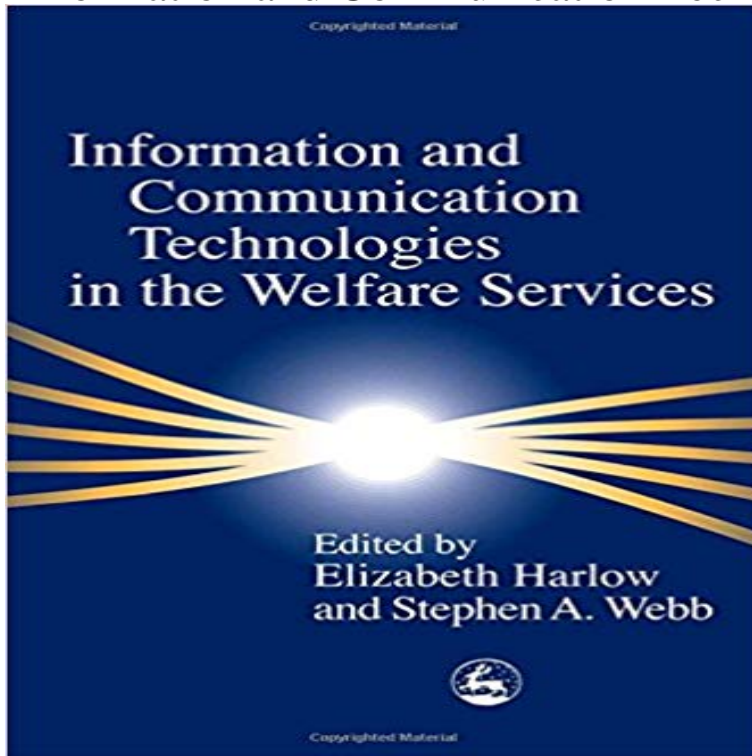


Information and Communication Technology in the Welfare Services
