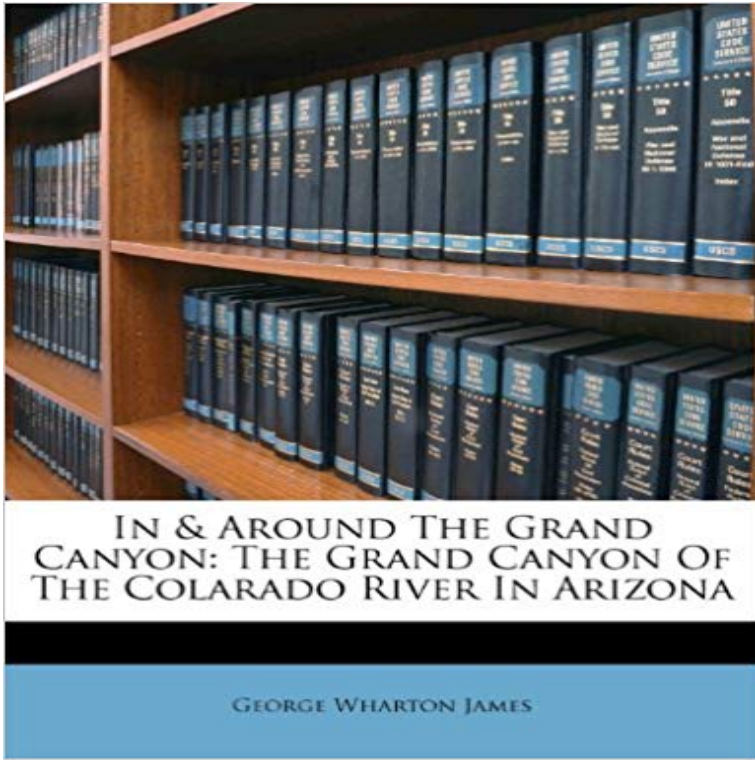


In & Around The Grand Canyon: The Grand Canyon Of The Colorado River In Arizona
