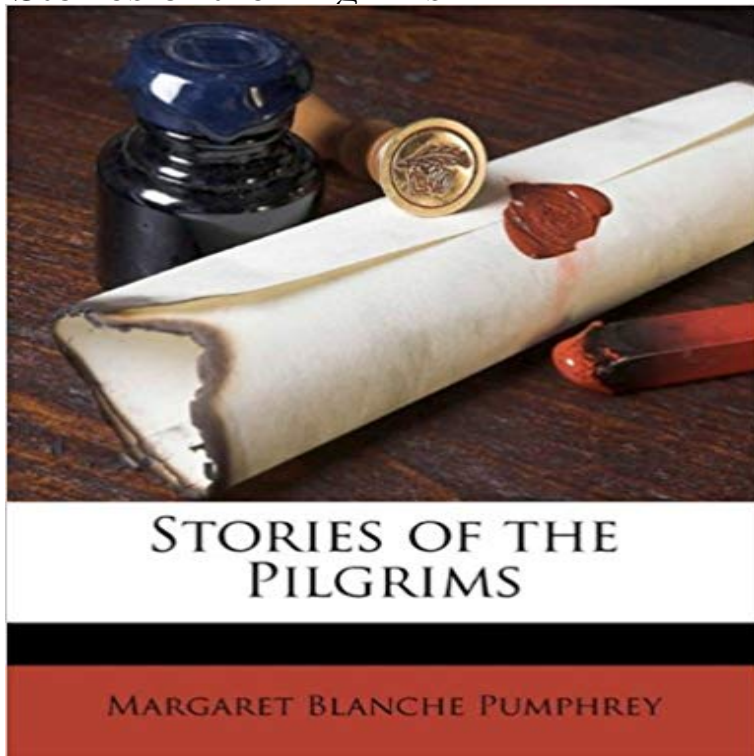


## Stories of the Pilgrims
