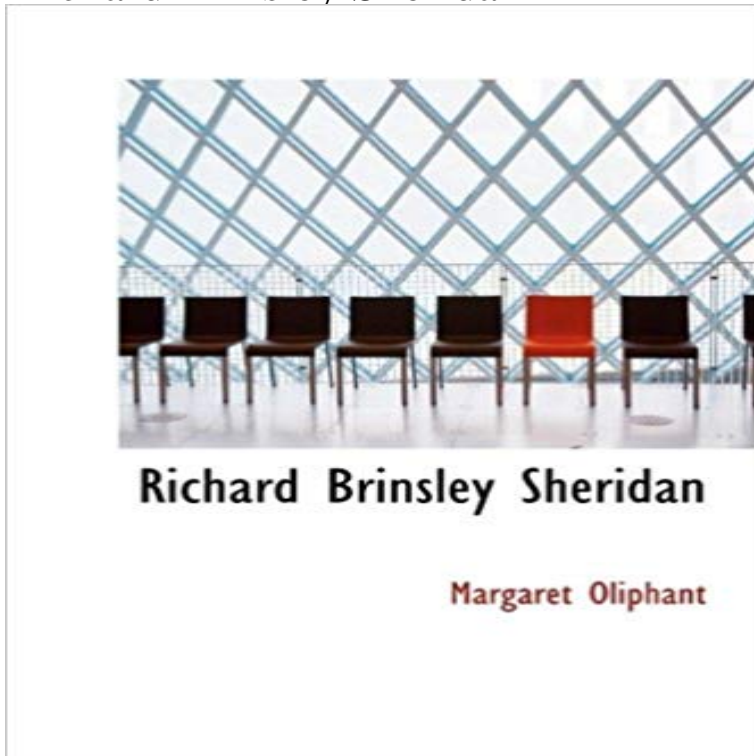


## Richard Brinsley Sheridan
