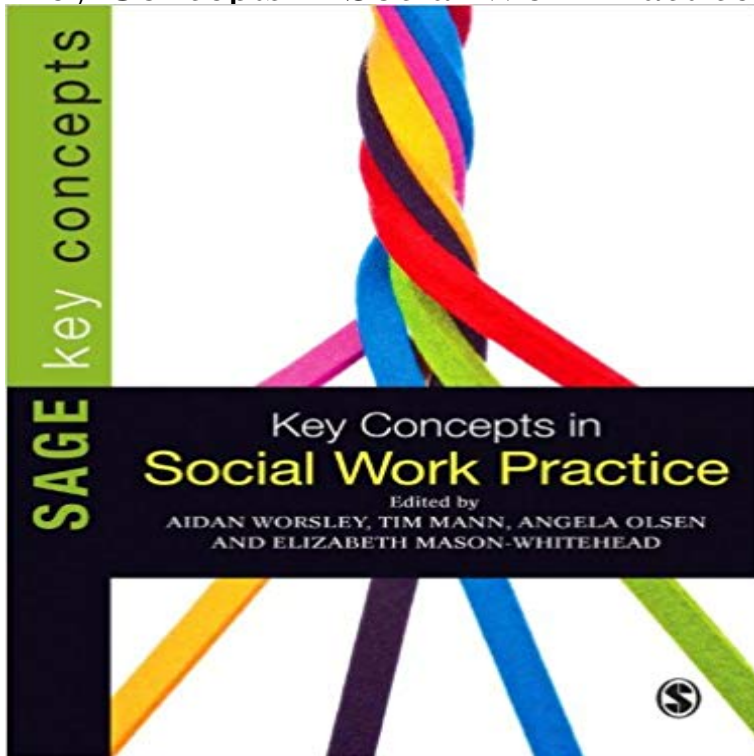


Key Concepts in Social Work Practice (SAGE Key Concepts series)
