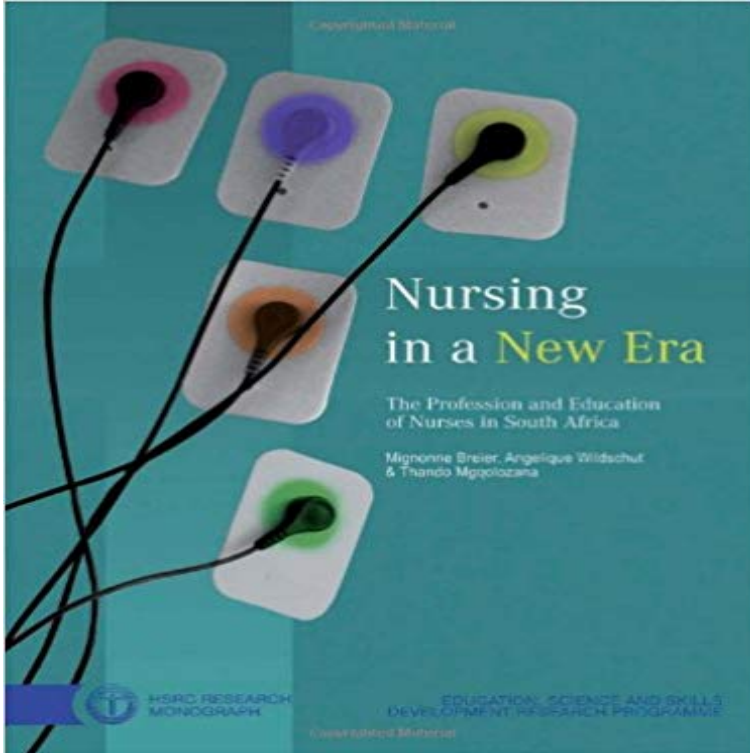


Nursing in a New Era: The Profession and Education of Nurses in South Africa (Professions and Professional Education s)

Also providing a broad outline of the state of South African healthcare and the burden of the HIV and AIDS epidemic, this is an important look at the challenges of nurses and what can be done to reverse the worrying trends.
