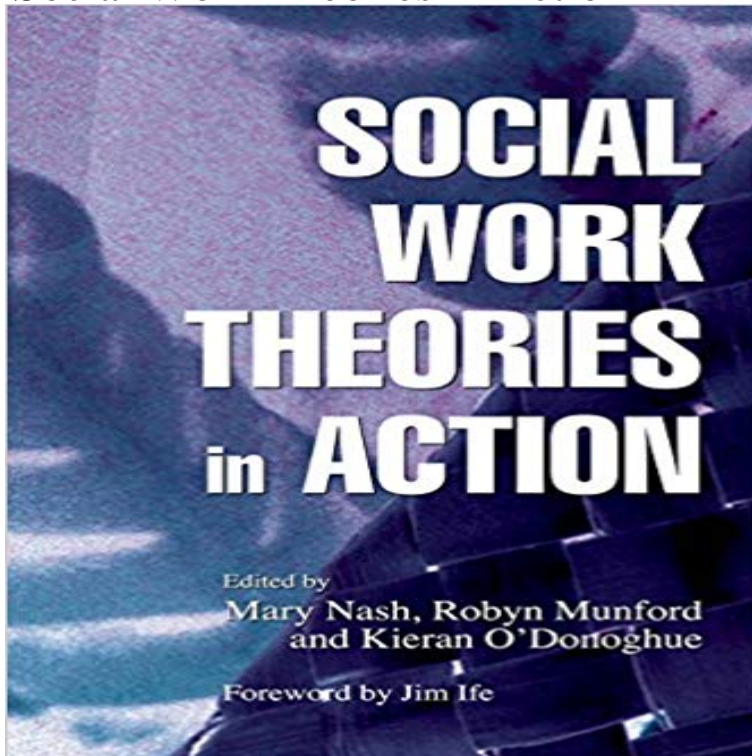


Social Work Theories in Action
