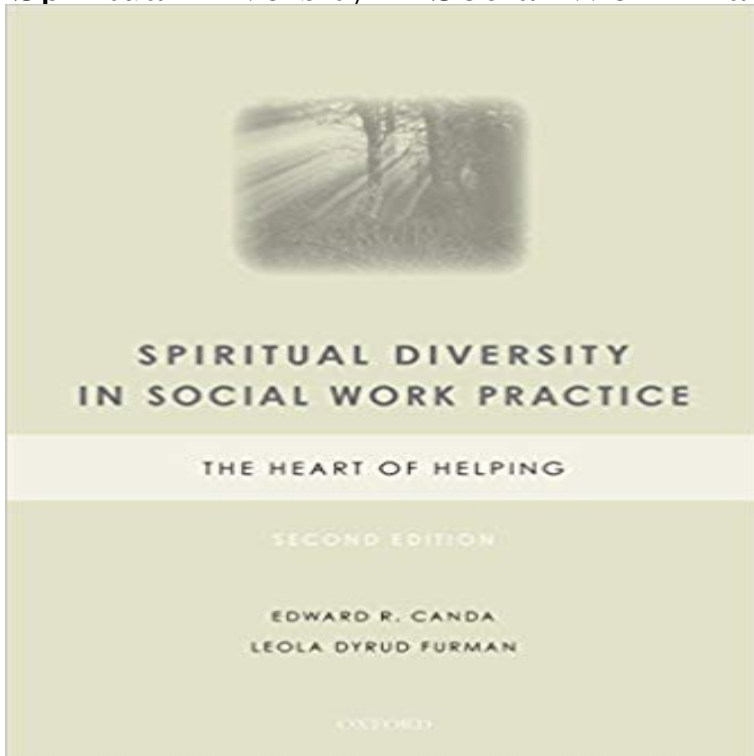


Spiritual Diversity in Social Work Practice: The Heart of Helping
