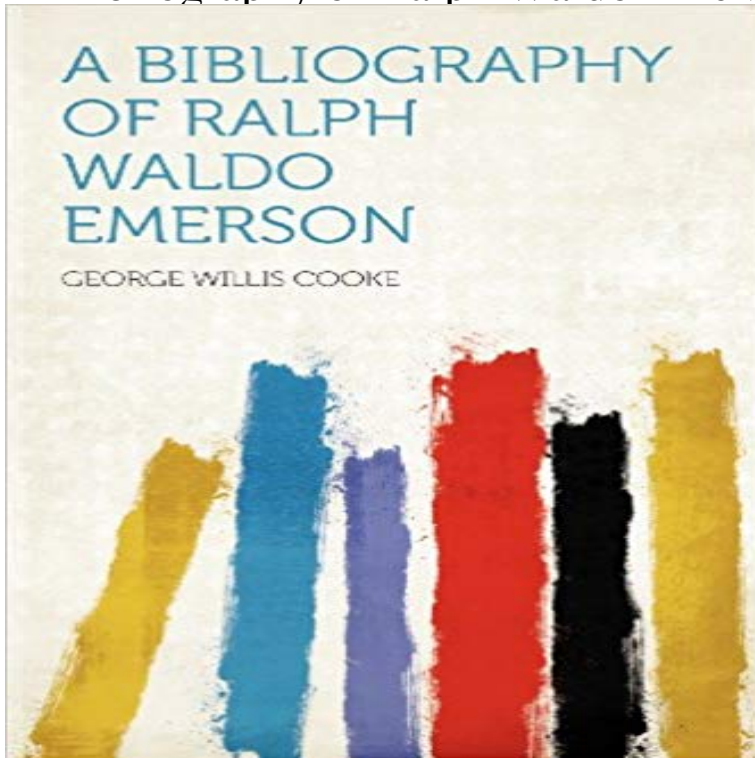


A Bibliography of Ralph Waldo Emerson
