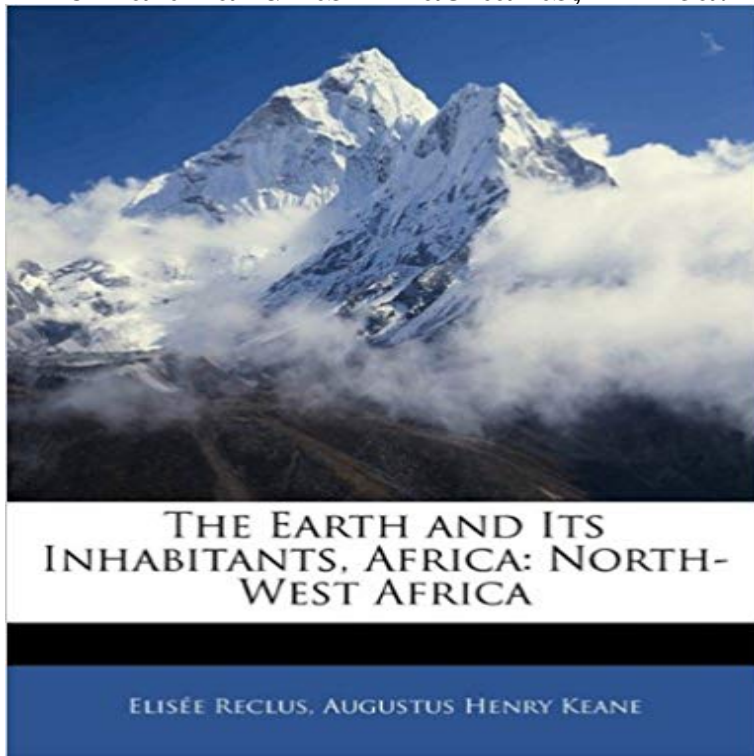


The Earth and Its Inhabitants, Africa: North-West Africa
