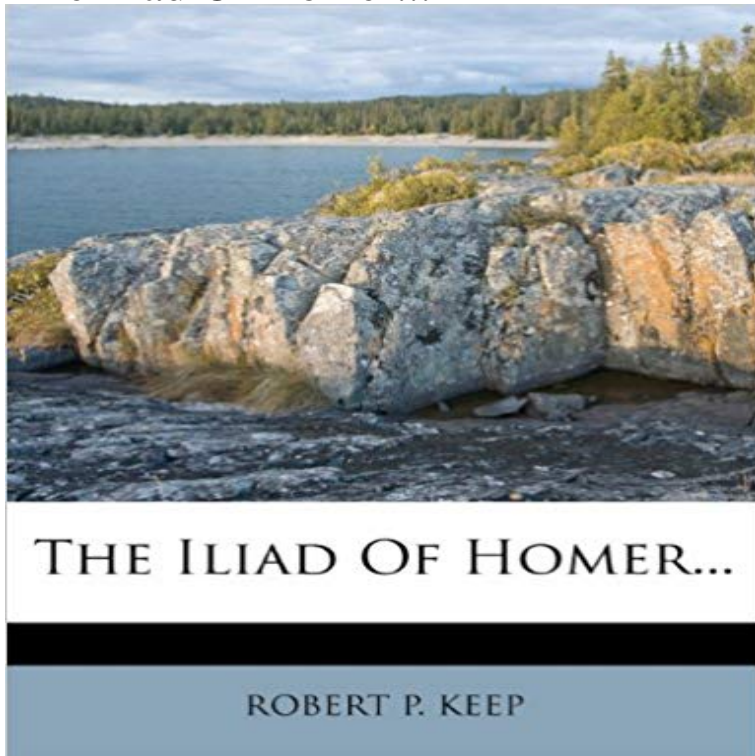


The Iliad Of Homer...
