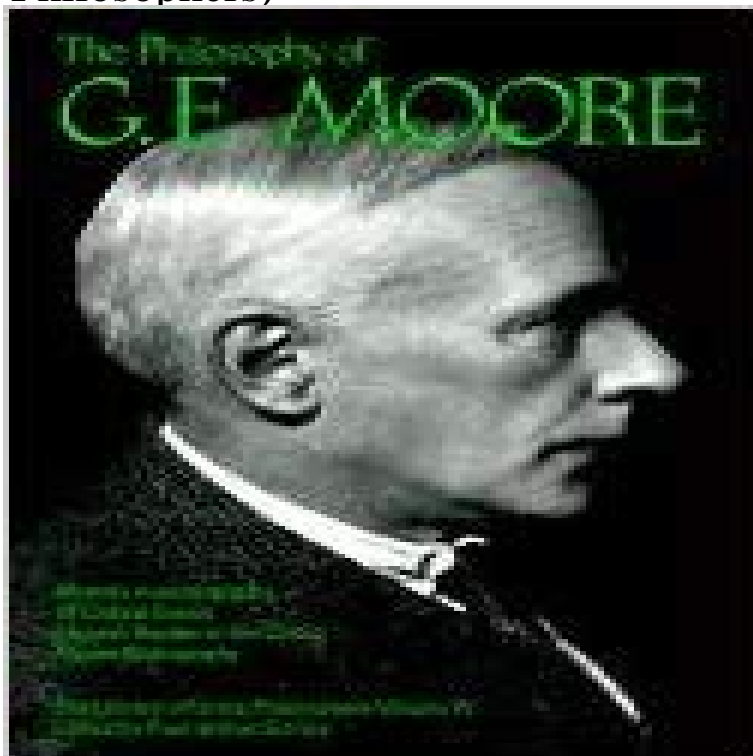


The Philosophy of G. E. Moore, Volume 4 (Library of Living Philosophers)
