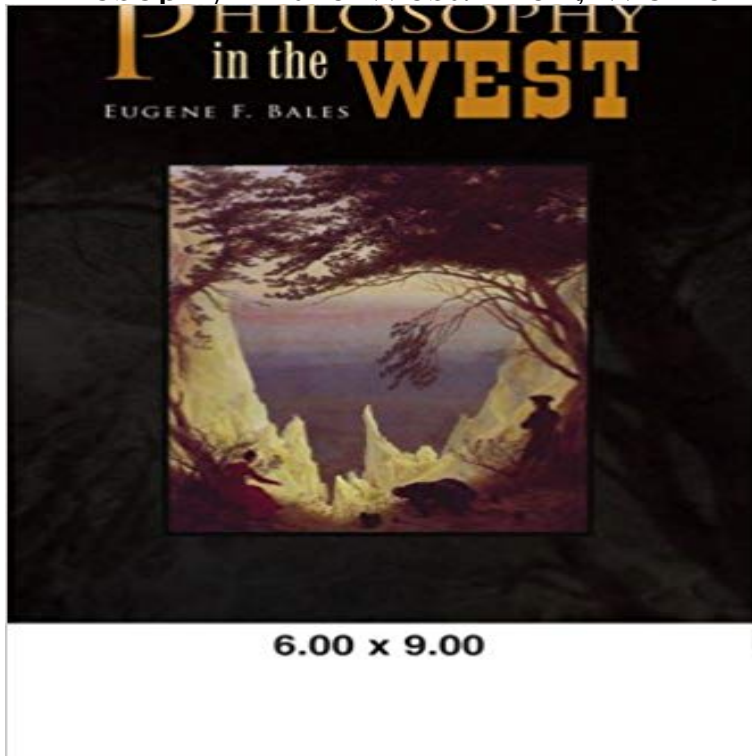


Philosophy in the West: Men, Women, Religion, Science
