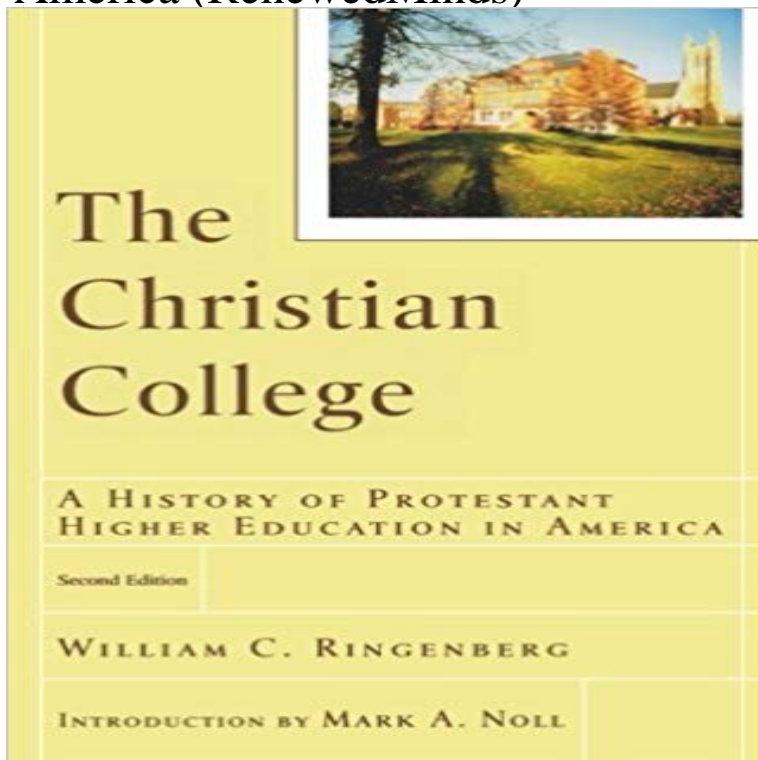


The Christian College: A History of Protestant Higher Education in America (RenewedMinds)
