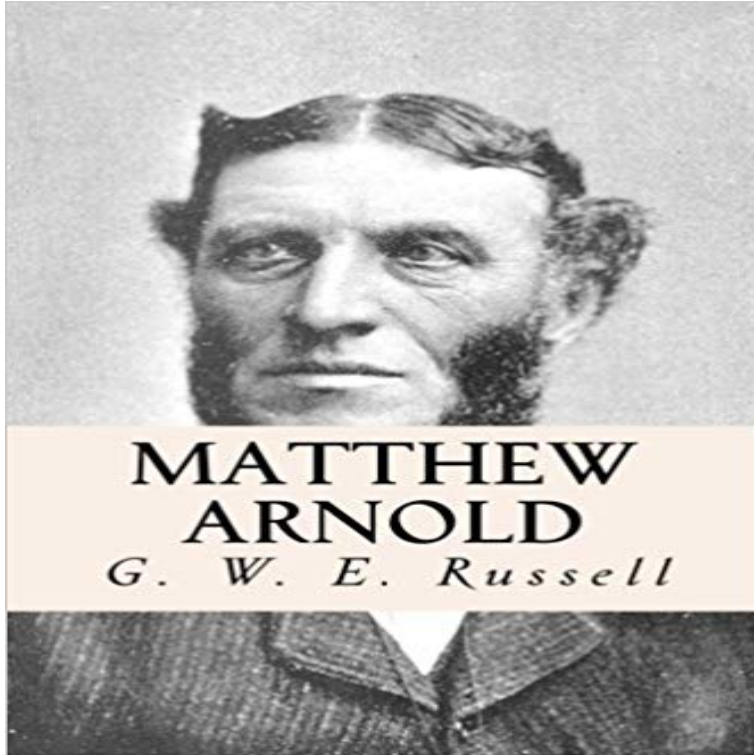


Matthew Arnold
